MDI relies on volunteer dentists for scheduling. Because of it, we work hard to provide as many options as we can; however, we base the schedule around the scheduled days of each dentist.

Dental Hygiene – MDI has Dental Hygienists on staff that provide cleanings for all ages.

<u>General Dentistry</u> – MDI has approximately 40 dentists in the area that volunteer their time. These providers offer simple extractions, fillings, anterior root canals, and denture services.

<u>Oral Surgeons</u> – There are times that an extraction is beyond a general dentist's comfort zone. Thankfully, MDI can refer patients to Madison Oral Surgeons and Center for Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.

<u>Endodontists</u> – MDI performs root canals on a limited basis and the tooth needs to qualify for this service. If a tooth qualifies for this service, MDI will either perform the root canal at our clinic or refer to Madison Endodontic Associate

To Qualify for Services:

- 1. Patient must be a resident of Dane County
- 2. Individuals must have NO private dental insurance (BadgerCare, Medicaid plans accepted)
- 3. Individuals must have family income below 200% of Federal Poverty Level

What to bring:

- 1. Patients must bring proof of residence such as:
 - Driver's License
 - Utility Bill
 - Cable Bill
 - Lease
- 2. Patients must submit proof of family income such as (Bring all that apply)
 - Food Share
 - Social Security and SSI
 - Wages from job
 - Unemployment/Worker's Compensation
 - Pension
 - Last year's W2 or 1099
 - Child Support
